District Director Caltrans District 12

Ryan Chamberlain is Caltrans District 12 Director and a more than 20-year veteran of the California Department of Transportation.

Chamberlain has extensive experience in the transportation sector, including Caltrans headquarters, Districts 7 and 12, and in the private sector. Prior to his return to District 12, Chamberlain was appointed by Governor Brown to serve as the Chief Deputy Director for Caltrans, where he was responsible for overseeing the internal operations of over 20,000 employees and an annual budget that exceeded \$13 billion.

Chamberlain is known for his ability to build partnerships with the business community, regional transportation agencies, counties, and cities. His innovation and leadership resulted in the advancement of key initiatives and projects that will benefit generations of users of the State's transportation network, including the I-405 Improvement Project, the second-largest highway construction project in California's history.

Chamberlain graduated from the University of California, Santa Barbara, with a degree in environmental studies. He and his wife, Jodi, have two children.
