Director, Caltrans District 8

Mr. Michael D. Beauchamp is the District Director of Caltrans District 8, which serves San Bernardino and Riverside Counties. His Caltrans career began in July of 1983, shortly after he earned his Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from Michigan State University in March. He received his California Professional Civil Engineer Certificate in August of 1987.

In his 35 plus years' experience working for Caltrans, Mike has held many positions in Caltrans. Most recently, he was the Deputy District Director of the Construction Division in District 8. He has also served as a Resident Engineer, Construction Engineer, Branch Chief, Office Chief, and Area Construction Manager. Mike has worked in District 8 Design, District 8 Construction, Structure Design, and at the Southern Regional Lab. He also provided leadership to District 9, which serves Kern, Inyo and Mono Counties, overseeing Divisions of Administration, Maintenance, Operations, Project Management, and Planning as their Acting District Director.

During his career he has been part of award-winning teams who worked on high-profile District 8 projects such as at the 60/91/215 interchange in Riverside; the I- 10/ I-215 interchange in San Bernardino; the I-15/ I-210 interchange in Rancho Cucamonga and various segments along Interstates 15, 40, 210, and 215.
