Joy Buenaflor Deputy Director of Transit and Rail Programs (SBCTA)

Joy Buenaflor is the Deputy Director of Transit and Rail Programs at the San Bernardino County Transportation Authority (SBCTA), where she is responsible for the delivery of capital projects.



She currently serves as the Project Manager for the Zero Emission Multiple Unit Project, the first compliant hydrogen passenger rail in North America and the West Valley Connector Bus Rapit Transit which will operate battery electric buses. Joy joined SBCTA in August of 2022 after 6 years working with the agency as extension of staff. Joy has a diverse background in program/project management, contract administration and grant funding, having worked in both the public and private sectors for more than 24 years delivering highways and transit and rail programs. Joy has a degree in finance and holds a master's in business administration.



Philip Chu Deputy Director of Express Lanes (SBCTA)

Philip Chu serves as the Deputy Director of Express Lanes at the San Bernardino County Transportation Authority (SBCTA), where he oversees the delivery and operations of the I-10 and I-15 Express Lanes—two vital corridors supporting regional mobility across Southern California.

With over 25 years of experience in transportation planning, program management, and express lanes operations, Philip

has played a key role in advancing multimodal infrastructure and funding strategies. Since joining SBCTA in 2008 as a Management Analyst in Fund Administration, he has led a wide range of federal, state, and local transportation funding programs. Prior to SBCTA, he worked at the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG) as an Associate Planner, focusing on regional planning, traffic modeling, socioeconomic forecasting, and motorist aid programs. Philip holds a degree in City & Regional Planning and a Master of Public Policy from California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. Beyond his professional role, Philip is deeply committed to education and public service. He has taught public policy, public finance, and transportation planning as an adjunct lecturer for over a decade at both Cal State San Bernardino and UC Irvine. He also serves as a Planning Commissioner for the City of Pomona and volunteers as an advisory board member for the Public Administration Department at CSUSB.
